

Suggested High School Supplies

General

- Loose-leaf, three-hole, college-ruled paper for notetaking
- Graph paper for math classes
- Binder with dividers, or folders for classes (depending on student's individual study habits)
- Student planner – highly recommended
- USB drive

English

- Composition book for taking notes. College or wide-ruled.

International Language

- French: Good quality bilingual dictionary
- Spanish IV: Notebook to keep journal

Mathematics

- All math students need a TI-84 Plus calculator.
- Geometry students need a compass, straight edge, and protractor.

Religious Studies

- Sacred Art students will need one drawing pencil (2B) and one blank sketch book, 7" x 10" or 8.5" x 11". Mix Media (wet & dry) paper weight required. Sketchbook will be collected and should not be shared with any other classes in which the student is enrolled.

Science

- Biology I students need an 8.5" x 11" (not the smaller composition size) spiral or sewn-bound notebook with at least 100 pages that do not easily tear out. Pages may be college-ruled or graph paper. Students also need assorted colored pens and highlighters.
- Chemistry students need a folder or binder for collecting handouts and other papers for class and should have a spiral-bound notebook for taking notes and completing homework.
- Chemistry II students need a composition lab-style notebook for labs, with pages sewn in, not stapled or spiral-bound.
- Physics I & II students need one 7.5" x 9.75" composition style lab book for notes. The pages should be sewn in, not stapled or spiral-bound. Students may use wide or college-ruled. Students will also need 2 different colored pens (other than blue/black), a protractor, a compass and a ruler.
